

REPORT LAYOUT GUIDE FOR

MICHIGAN SCHOOL INDEX SYSTEM

Indicator Descriptions

- 1) The Overview tile and value displays the overall, school-level index value on a scale of 0-100 determined for the selected school.
- 2) The Support Category tile displays a support label if the selected school was identified for school support and improvement needs. If the selected school was not identified for improvement, this tile will appear in grey and have no label.
- 3) The Growth Overview tile displays a 0-100 student growth performance index in ELA and math for the selected school if applicable.
- 4) The Proficiency Overview tile displays a 0-100 student proficiency performance index in ELA and math for the selected school if applicable.
- 5) The Graduation Rate Overview tile displays a 0-100 graduation rate index across 4, 5, a 6-year cohort graduation rates for the selected school if applicable.
- 6) English Learner Progress Overview tile displays a 0-100 student proficiency and growth performance index for English language learners in the selected school if applicable.
- 7) The School Quality and Student Success Overview tile displays a combined 0-100 performance index in the areas of on-track attendance, postsecondary enrollment, advanced coursework completion, and staffing ratios where applicable.
- 8) The Assessment Participation Overview tile displays a 0-100 student participation index on state assessments in ELA, math, science, and social studies combined for the selected school where applicable.

Click "View More" on any overview tile to see more details and information.

The Michigan School Index System report shows federally-required school accountability measures under the *Every Student Succeeds Act* (ESSA) of 2015. The data are important because they represent the official determination of school status. Up to six components make up a school's overall index value:

- Student participation on state assessments (all tested subject areas);
- Student proficiency on state assessments (ELA and Math only);
- Student growth on state assessments (ELA and Math only);
- Student graduation rates;
- English Learner progress on the WIDA ACCESS assessment;
- Measures of School Quality/Student Success which include:
 - K-12 On Track Attendance (Chronic Absenteeism)
 - K-8 Access to Arts/Physical Education
 - K-8 Access to Librarians/Media Specialists
 - 11-12 Advanced Coursework
 - Postsecondary Enrollment

The index system calculates values from 0-100 for the school overall, as well as any components or subgroups within the school. Index values are based on the degree to which schools met targets in the different components.

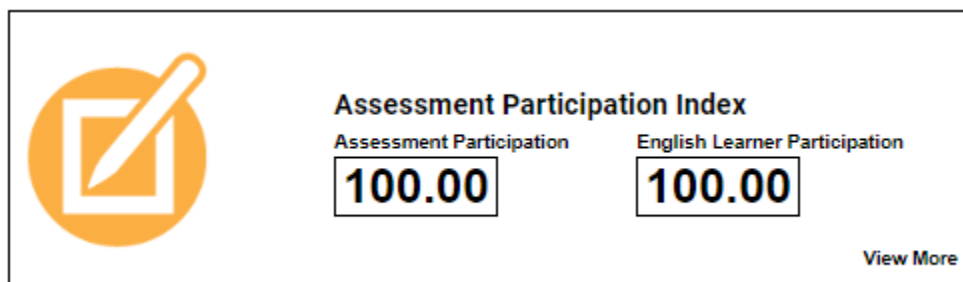
Notes for 2017-18:

- There are no Comprehensive Support and Intervention (CSI) schools this year, so no threshold. The next round of identifications will occur in Fall 2020.
- Component Targets remain the same as 2016-17
- **During the preview window only**, schools will need to click on “**New School Index**” in the K-12th Grade menu to get to the 17-18 index. Once public, both 16-17 and 17-18 will be available under “School Index”

- The Assessment Participation Overview tile will have two index values for 17-18. One for the M-STEP, MI-Access and MME tests, and one for WIDA



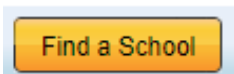

Option 1: Use the “K-12th Grade” menu, then click on “School Index”

Use “Find a School” to select a building



Select a “Key Performance Indicator”, then “View More” to compare building to index.

Each of the 8 Key Performance Indicators provides information for improvement.

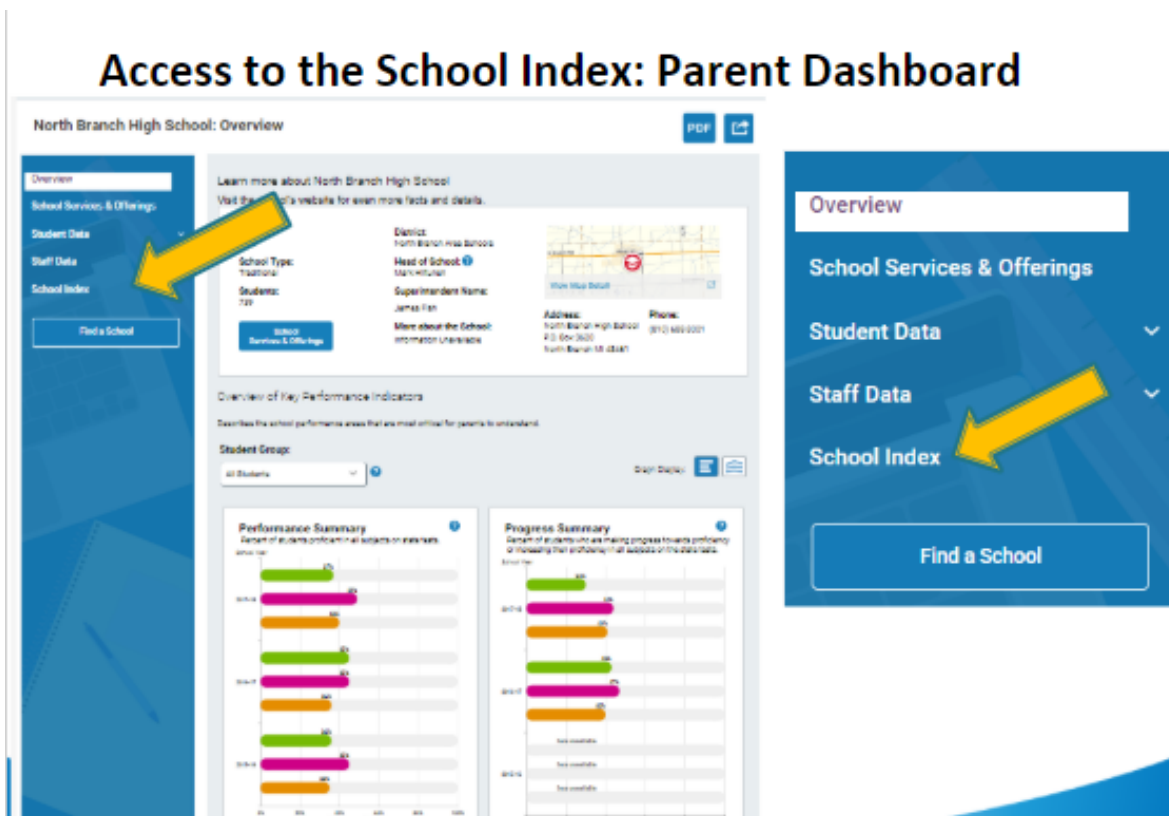
Access to the School Index: K-12th Grade
